The *Umoja Online Community of Practice* (*OCoP*) will serve as an online platform for Umoja practitioners to continue to engage one another with dialogue and receive on-going support and training from the Statewide Umoja Community.

The document provides a site map to the Umoja OCoP with the intention of allowing you to have a quick overview of how the Canvas course site is organized. An OCoP is a very dynamic site so it is expected that this document will need to be updated occasionally. Although there are links provide within the site map, be advised that for the OCoP is a closed community; you need to be enrolled as a participant to view the content. Enrolling is easy!

To Enroll in the Umoja OCoP:

It will immediately log you into the course once you enroll but you need to check your email to complete the enrollment by creating a password. If you do not create your password, you won't be able to re-login at a later date.

Site Map

The site map consist of the **Navigation, Modules, and Discussions**. Navigation is the main menu items located on the left side of the course and the primary way participants will access resources. Modules are "folders" in the site that group resources (pages, link to external resources, link to discussions, etc) into categories. Discussions are text forums where participants can engage with others and share/upload files to share.
