Ida B. Wells was an African American journalist, newspaper editor, suffragist, sociologist, Georgist, and an early leader in the Civil Rights Movement.

Martin Luther King, Jr. was an American Baptist minister, activist, humanitarian, and leader in the African American Civil Rights Movement.

Booker T. Washington was an African American educator, author, orator, and advisor to presidents of the United States.

Shirley Anita St. Hill Chisholm was an American politician, educator, and author. In 1968, she became the first African American woman elected to the United States Congress.
