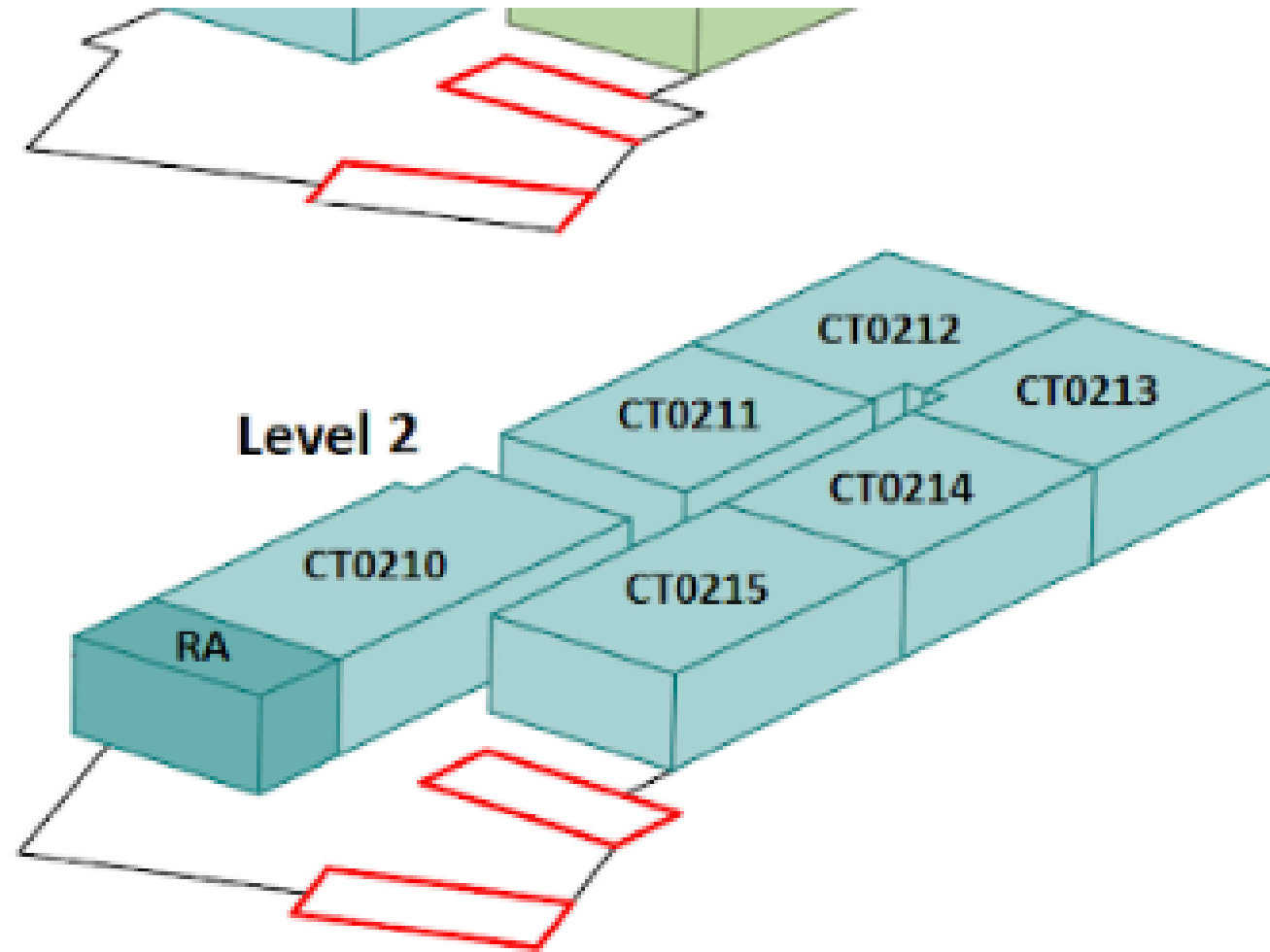
WHAT IS NOT?

- No Cleaning Supplies (We will have supplies available)



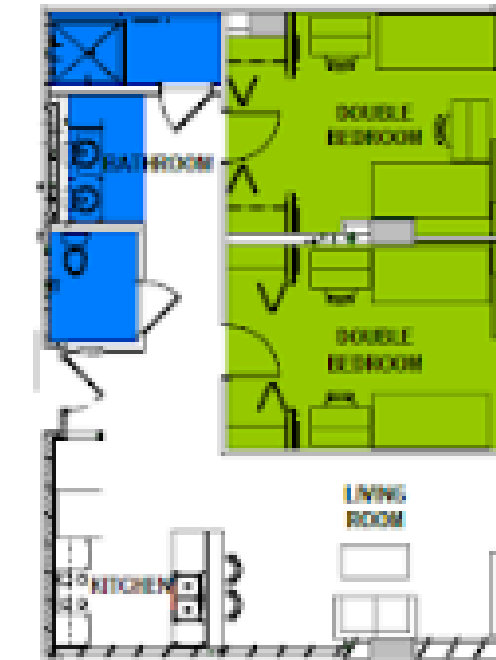

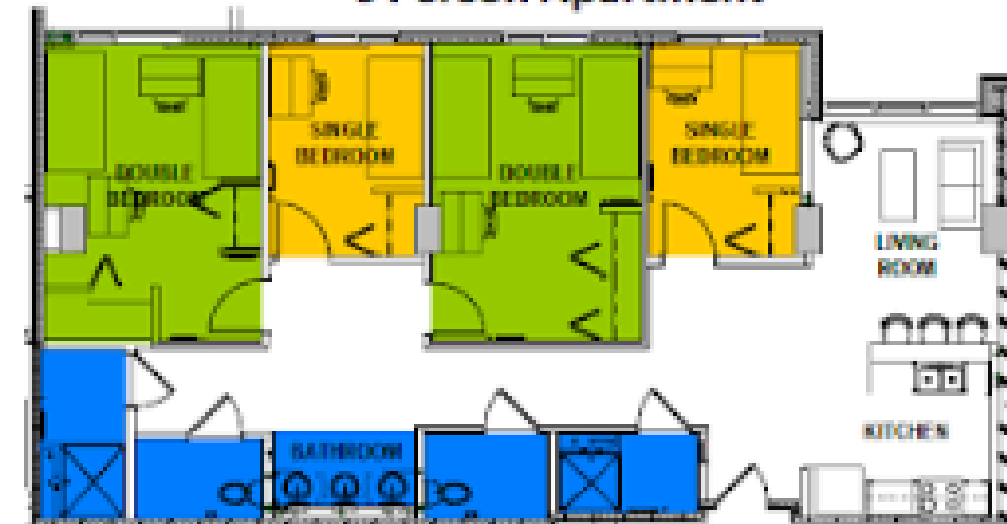

UMOJA STUDENT ADVOCACY RESEARCH PROJECT

We believe that when the voices and histories of students are deliberately and intentionally recognized, the opportunity for self-efficacy emerges and a foundation is formed for academic success.

UMOJA STUDENT ADVOCACY RESEARCH PROJECT OBJECTIVES

1. Activate Students to Advocate and Understand the Power of Advocacy.
2. Help Students with Understanding Data and the Role that Plays in Advocacy.
3. Support Practitioners in Developing Student Leaders

BUILDING ACADEMIC COMPETENCIES

Students build a number of academic competencies grounded in college-level research skill building:

- Language acquisition
- Functional literacy development
- Reading and synthesizing expository text (college-level articles)
- Learning how to cite (APA)
- Creating claims
- Developing surveys (checking for validity) and interview protocols
- Administering surveys and conducting interviews
- Data analysis (themes, connecting to claims, etc.)

UMOJA STUDENT ADVOCACY RESEARCH PROJECT

What We Will Do At SLS

1. Students Develop An Advocacy List. Ultimately we want to narrow down to a short term advocacy project (A few months) and a long term advocacy project (A lot of months to a few years).
2. Students Develop Research Questions Centered Around the Advocacy Issues.
3. Students Brainstorm Research Methods
